BPPV

A common cause of vertigo, characterised by a short and intense sense of vertigo, induced by certain head positions

Vestibular Migraines

Vertigo and dizziness associated with a migraine history

Vestibular Neuritis / Labyrinthitis

A sudden onset of intense vertigo and loss of balance (+/- hearing loss). This occurs due to a viral insult to the nerve connecting your balance centre

PPPD

Chronic dizziness and unsteadiness which is worsened by posture and complex visual surrounds - despite the vestibular system working well.

Peripheral Vestibular Hypofunction

When the balance centre is not working well (imbalance between left and right inner ears).

Meniere's Disease

Acute episodes of vertigo, hearing loss, tinnitus and ear fullness/pressure - as a result of build-up / abnormal movement of endolymphatic fluid inside the inner ear

Other Conditions

There are many other conditions impacting balance and causing dizziness, unsteadiness, and/or vertigo. These can be vestibular or neurological
